Music Tuition at Chulmleigh Community College from September 2018 is available with the following teachers

Fees for 2018-19 are £30 per hour (pro-rata) –

Rate A £15.00 per 1 to 1 lesson of 30 minutes x 10 week term = **£150 per term**

Rate B £ 10.00 per 1 to 1 lesson of 20 minutes x 10 week term = **£100 per term**

Rate C £ 7.50 per 1 to 2 lesson of 30 minutes x 10 week term = **£75.00 per term**

NB Rate C is only available if you have a definite person to share with and **indicate who you wish to share lessons with** on the reply slip below. It is **not** available for Piano, Keyboard or Drum Kit lessons.

Musical Instruments and College Scholarships: Students must provide their own instruments. Rental and Rent-to-Buy schemes are available from music shops. Purchase can be VAT free if made through the College (see Mr Cookson for details). The College also has a Scholarship scheme for students who regularly take part in extra-curricular music.

How to apply Complete, detach and return the form below to Mr Cookson who will pass it on to the appropriate tutor. Lessons are organised on a rota changing every two weeks (to match the College's two-week timetable). To minimise administration, you will only be contacted if we are not able to offer tuition. Students starting lessons for the very first time who are not used to the system will need to speak with Mr Cookson if they need clarification of how it all works.

Ensemble Opportunities: For instrumentalists, the College Orchestra is on Wednesday lunchtimes, Jammin (Improvisation group) is on Thursday lunchtimes and CMAc Brass, Woodwind and String ensembles are on Wednesdays after school to 5.00pm. For vocalists, CMAc Choir is on Wednesdays after school, Singing Club is on Tuesday lunchtimes.

Payments are due by no later than the first lesson of term, cheques made payable to the specific tutor (**NOT** to the College). Some tutors accept online payments and will provide you with their bank details on request.
