

Iceland – Monday 30th March until Friday 3rd April 2020

We are excited to be proposing a school tour to Iceland to support our curriculum plans for Geography pupils and enhance learning experiences within the school. Iceland is one of the most geographically fascinating countries in the world and our trip will hopefully offer pupils a really unique and memorable experience.

The trip is aimed at current year 9 and 10 pupils and will take place from 30th March until 3rd April. We will travel to the airport by coach, the specific travel details will be confirmed when the flight times are published. This usually happens about 6 months in advance of departure.

Here are the key details about the planned trip:

- 5 days and 4 nights
- The purpose of the trip is to inspire pupils by visiting amazing geographical sites
- The provisional cost is £913.00 per pupil.
- This price includes:
 - Return executive coach travel
 - Return flights
 - Accommodation - Hotel Viking Village on a half board basis
 - Travel insurance
 - A professional guide
 - Reykjavik city centre coach

I have included a brief overview of our itinerary below:

Day 1	Daytime flight & transfer to the accommodation
Day 2	South Shore adventure day - including visits to Skogafoss, Reynisfjara, Solheimajokull & Seljalansfoss
Day 3	Golden Circle adventure day - including visits to Hellshedi Power Station, Kerid, Gulfoss, Geysir & Thingvellir and Secret Lagoon
Day 4	Reykjanes Peninsula day – including visits to Lake Kleifarvatn, Seltun, Stora Eldborg & Grindavik
Day 5	Transfer to airport for return flight to UK

As well as being one of most geographically interesting places in the world Iceland is also unfortunately one of the most expensive and this is reflected in the cost of visiting the country. I have spent time comparing different packages from a variety of travel companies and believe that this trip offers us best value. Hopefully with over a year to pay for the trip enough pupils will be able to take up this amazing opportunity.

In addition to the tour cost, we recommend that your child has £100 spending money for the trip (they will need to buy lunch each day). They will also require a current passport.

The trip is being booked through NST Travel who are the UK's leading educational travel company for schools with more than 50 years' experience. They work closely with us during the whole tour planning process to ensure that your child will get the very best learning experience whilst away. We are able to take a group of 30 pupils, should the trip be oversubscribed, pupils will be randomly selected in a fair and transparent way in order to allocate places.
