

GCSE Art & Textiles - Trip to St. Ives, Oct 2019

I am pleased to offer a fantastic opportunity for Art and Textile GCSE pupils to experience the stunning landscapes and the range of galleries and workshops on offer in the coastal town of St. Ives. St. Ives has a reputation for being an inspiring location for artists and a culture of creativity. This trip is intended to enhance GCSE Art and Textile courses. Pupils will be given the opportunity to experience museums and attend workshops led by local artists to support their coursework for the GCSEs. We will visit The Tate Gallery and The Barbra Hepworth Museum. In addition, we will work with a local artist to complete a sketching tour of St. Ives and have time to explore the town and its many galleries.

The trip will take place from Friday 4th October to Sunday 6th October. We will be leaving from the school at 15:40 on Friday, returning to the school at approximately 15:00 on Sunday. Accommodation has been provisionally held at the Cohort Hostel, St. Ives which specialises in hosting school trips.

The cost of the trip will vary depending on the exact numbers for workshops and accommodation, but will be between £130 and £170. This will cover return coach fares to St. Ives, breakfast at the hostel, a packed lunch for Saturday and Sunday, fish and chip style dinner on Friday evening and a 2 course meal at Pizza Express on Saturday evening, insurance and all workshop and gallery entrance fees.

To secure the trip we need to have an idea of numbers in the first instance. To express your interest, please complete the form attached and return with an initial £50.00 deposit by **Friday 17th May** at the latest. Please note that numbers are limited to 44 pupils. Should the trip be oversubscribed, names of pupils will be randomly selected in a fair and transparent way in order to allocate places. Your deposit will secure the coach, workshop and accommodation bookings, it will be refundable if the trip does not proceed. Should the trip go ahead as planned, the deposit will not be refunded unless we are able to find another pupil who can attend. Our preferred method for payment is via portal.squidcard.com. Cheques should be made payable to Chulmleigh Academy Trust.
