| <p>Key skills/words</p> <p><i>Citizenship</i> - the rights, duties and privileges of being a citizen. <i>Rights</i> - legal, social or ethical ideas of freedom or entitlement. <i>Responsibilities</i> - actions and attitudes that support society. <i>Respect</i> - regard for the feelings, wishes and rights of others. <i>The Universal Declaration of Human Rights (UDHR)</i>: the thirty agreed human rights as agreed in 1948 by the 56 members of The United Nations. <i>Discrimination</i> - acting on prejudice. <i>Asylum</i> - the protection granted by a state to someone who has left their home country as a political refugee.</p> <p>Key Skills: To understand why people do what they do. To be aware of a person who works for peace.</p> | <p>Key skills/words</p> <p><i>Binge Drinking</i> - the consumption of an excessive amount of alcohol in a short period of time <i>Depressant</i> - chiefly of a drug) reducing functional or nervous activity. <i>Illegal</i> - contrary to or forbidden by law, especially criminal law. <i>Infographic</i> - a visual representation of information or data, e.g. as a chart or diagram. <i>Attitude</i> - a settled way of thinking or feeling about something <i>Participation</i> - the action of taking part in something <i>Islamophobia</i> - dislike of or prejudice against Islam or Muslims, especially as a political force.</p> <p>Key skills: To be able to make informed decisions.
