They could not have achieved what they have without your support. We've all worked together, with them, to get them to this point. They have had the type of education that we would want for our children and we are proud of what they have achieved.

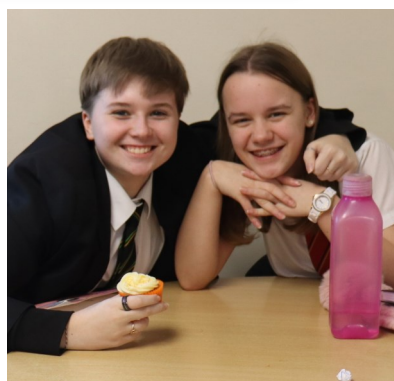

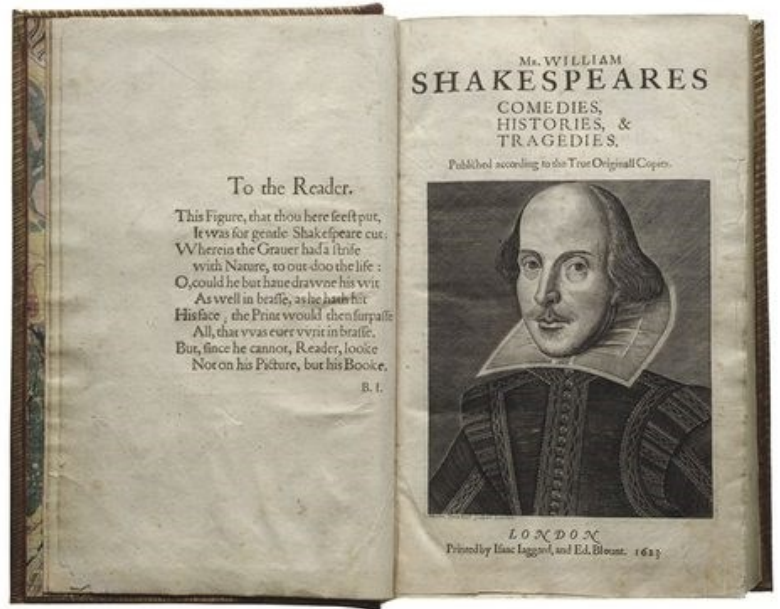


# 2024 SHAKESPEARE SCHOOLS FESTIVAL

For many years, Ms Feasey's GCSE Drama classes have taken part in the annual National Shakespeare for Schools Festival. The festival puts pupils in touch with directors and actors from theatres across the country as they perform one of the Bard's great plays with their own take on one of his world famous works. The culmination of the festival sees our pupils perform on stage at the Barnfield Theatre, Exeter, in front of a packed audience! This is a real highlight of our College calendar, and is perhaps particularly special in 2024, when we celebrate the 400 year anniversary of the publication of the First Folio. This year our GCSE Drama class are performing one of those plays - their version of Macbeth, which Ms Feasey describes as a play about grief and madness in a world where strength matters. There is so much to stretch and challenge our pupils within this.

We were pleased to welcome Elyott to the college on Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> January who is a nationally recognised Director and Theatre-Maker based in the South West. Elyott spent the afternoon working alongside Ms Feasey and the pupils and was full of praise for the wonderful work of our pupils and their director. The performance is being accompanied by Mr Cookson and his Year 10 GCSE Music Class - a wonderful collaboration from our ever-popular Expressive Arts Department. ## ***Year 10 Kick Off The Rugby Season***

Before the deep freeze set in, we managed to play our first rugby fixture against South Molton. Captain Charlie Broomfield lead the team out with a slightly different line up to last season. Through our curriculum, our students have grown in confidence, gained knowledge of rugby and braved the elements to represent school. New players Oliver Webber (second row), George Cook (hooker) and George Taylor (winger) as well as Richard Stanbury (first in play for Chulmleigh and has recently joined South Molton Rugby Club).

With some nerves in the team, they came out of the blocks with 100% gusto! We were camped in their half for most of the first half and South Molton only crossed the half way line twice and unfortunately the second time resulted in a try. Our inexperience only showed in the rucks when many penalties were awarded against us and we allowed them 10 more meters. When we had the ball in hand, we looked good and were able to string some great passes together. Compared to our opposition, we had more to our game than giving it to a forward and charging through the middle.

We were only 1 try down at half time and this was a pleasant surprise to everyone! 2 minutes into the second half, after another beautiful piece of handling by a combination of forwards and back; running on to ball and off loading before being tied up, we scored! Logun Holden (prop) took a quick penalty and used his wheels to run around the opposition to slam it down.

It was a little while before the next try and this was purely our inexperience on our try line which gave them possession to score. Finally seconds before the whistle and before the pitch black descended on us, South Molton scored another try finishing 17-5. A very respectable score for a team with few club players. Well done to Ferdy Dickinson for keeping his cool despite playing against most of his teammates from South Molton RFC. Player of the match goes to Logun Holden for being the furthest meters gained throughout the game; especially when he played 1 game in Yr7 and then told me rugby wasn't for him – what a fantastic player he has become!

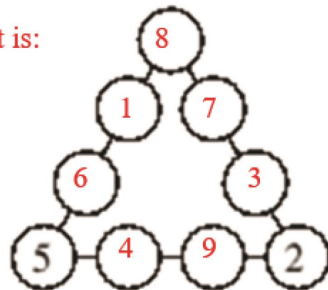

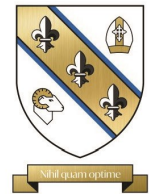
