### **Our Learning**

#### **Acorns**

This half term we will be learning about the Great Fire of London in our topic work. Our book in Literacy for the next few weeks is called Mole's Sunrise. In maths we will start looking at multiplication and division. We have an exciting half term planned and hope to visit a local fire station too.

#### **Oaks**

Oaks have been making the classroom into a tropical rainforest as an emersion task for our topic. We have also started learning about geometry including 3D and 2D shapes, co-

ordinates and symmetry. Please use Mathletics to revise maths covered last term such as addition, subtraction, multiplication, data handling and measurement.

#### **Garden**

The children have been asked to re-design our garden to make it a more functional area. It needs to contain 15-20 raised gardens (these could be larger areas that can be broken up). We would like to retain more of the trees and there needs to be space for the benches for outdoor lessons and packed lunches. The pond will stay where it is. The rest is up to the children!

It would be fantastic if designs could be 3D and these will be displayed in the hall but a bird's eye view can also be entered.

## Kitchen Project Starts

East Worlington Parish Hall Committee would like to thank our community for tremendous support during 2017.

As we come to the end of the year we can confirm that the kitchen project, which has been two years in the planning and fund-raising, is now underway.

The first tasks, which were undertaken by community volunteers on 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> December, were to clear the kitchen cutlery, crockery and equipment and put it in storage and to remove the old kitchen units. The contractors are planning to start on 3<sup>rd</sup> January 2018. The main building contractor is Steven Leach Building Services Ltd., the electrician Dart Electrics, and the plumber Martin Greenslade.

The kitchen will be decommissioned for approximately two months.

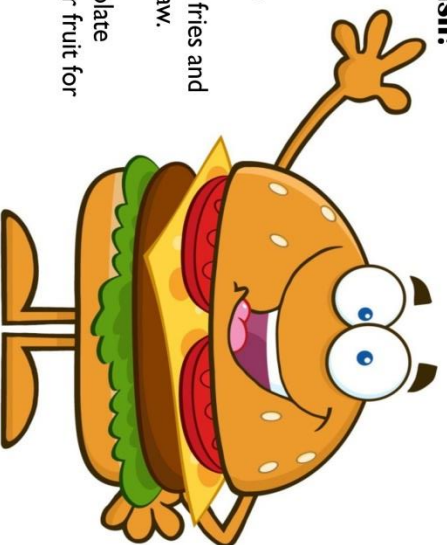
