Kingfishers' Class have been busy getting to grips with the place value of numbers in maths whilst building up their stamina for writing in their English lessons. The class are really enjoying our World War 2 topic and this week we have discussed

the horrendous Blitz, which lasted for 8 whole months and we have talked about what it may have been like for evacuees. The class created some fabulous Blitz artwork on Friday afternoon and these are now on display in the classroom.

Jays' Class have been working really hard this week with their Maths, doing lots of representing numbers in different ways and also partitioning numbers. In Literacy, we have been using our book 'The Stone Age Boy' to do some descriptive writing and thinking carefully about our capital letters, full stops and adjectives for description. In Topic, we have been learning about the different houses in the Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age and continued looking at cave paintings in Art. We even used charcoal to do our drawings like cave painters! We can't wait to finish our cave paintings in a few weeks; watch this space!

Robins' Class Robins Class have enjoyed our new topic Castles and Knights - the children received a letter from both the dragon and the knight from our class book 'The Knight and the Dragon' asking for their help - both characters are very scared of their upcoming battle! Children had to choose which team to be on - Team Knight or Team Dragon- each team made a large banner flag for their character and we had a class debate. The children have also been learning about the features of castles, and have been looking at the human body in preparation for creating useful armour next week. In Maths, we have been looking at one more/ less than given numbers and lots of different representations of each number. Reception children have learned the phonics sounds S, A and T and have been on a hunt to find objects beginning with these sounds!
