## Key vocabulary

**Textiles**-are a combination of flexible materials such as silk, wool, linen, cotton, such synthetic fibres as rayon, nylon, and polyesters.

**Weaving**- Weaving is a method of textile production in which two distinct sets of yarns or threads are interlaced at right angles to form a fabric or cloth.

**Embroidery**- the art of working raised and ornamental designs in threads of silk, cotton, gold, silver, or other material, upon any woven fabric, leather, paper, etc., with a needle.
