- Australia (also known as Australasia and Oceania)

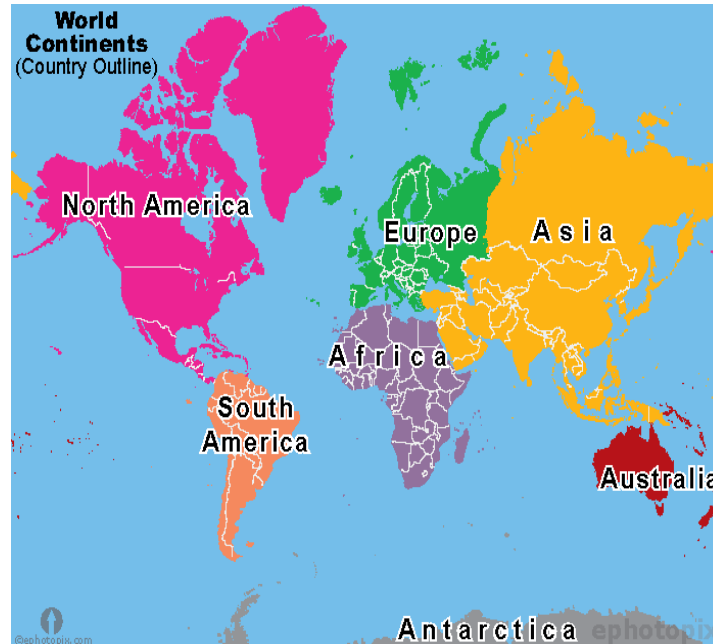
### Oceans

South America	Atlantic, Pacific	12	Brazil
Antarctica	Southern	—	—
Europe	Atlantic, Arctic	51	United Kingdom
Australia	Indian, Pacific	14	Australia

Aerial view	The view from above.
City	A large town. London is a city.
Compass Points	The main points on a compass, e.g. north, south, east, west.
Climate	Weather that is typical of a place
Forest	A large area where lots of trees grow close together.
Hill	A naturally raised area of land, not as high as a mountain.
Map	A flat picture of an area showing the main features such as land, ocean.
Seasons	The four natural periods of time that happen during every 12 month period: spring, summer, autumn, winter.
Weather	The conditions outdoors, for example it might be hot, cold, raining, sunny, windy, snowing, hailing.

Topic Vocabulary

Atlas	A book containing maps.
Climate	Weather that is typical of a place.
Continent	A very large area of land that consists of many <b>countries</b> . Europe is a <b>continent</b> .
Coast	The edge of the land where the land meets the sea.
Compass points	The main points on a compass, e.g. north, south, east, west.
Country	An area of land that has its own government. France is a country.
England	A country in the United Kingdom. East Worlington is in England.
Great Britain	An island that is made up of England, Scotland and Wales.
Island	A piece of land which is completely surrounded by water.
Landscape	All the visible features of an area, e.g. cliff, coast, hill, ground.
Ocean	One of the five very large areas of salt water on the Earth's surface.
Sea	A large area of salty water that is part of an ocean.
Surrounded	To be present all around.
United Kingdom	The UK, is officially known as the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland. It includes England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland.
Village	A small group of houses, perhaps with a few shops, that are often in the countryside. East Worlington is a village.
