Dear Parent(s) /Carer(s)

I am writing to inform you that East Worlington Primary School will be opening fully to all pupils from Monday, 8th March.

The return to school is vital for your child's education and welfare and we are very much looking forward to welcoming all pupils back to school.

It is imperative that we ensure that pupils return to school as positively and safely as possible. Therefore, our Risk Assessment will remain in place and all social distancing and hygiene measures will continue. A copy of the Risk Assessment will be emailed to you next Friday, 5th March, and I ask that you please familiarise yourselves with it, again.

Upon return, we hope to ease the pupils back into routine during the first week. We will continue to teach a broad curriculum with all National Curriculum subjects. Teachers will carry out assessments in order to target any specific gaps and in order to maximise learning opportunities. We will deliver Science Week during the week beginning 29th March, and children will enjoy a range of science activities and experiments in all classes.

Academic Reports will be moved forward to the Summer Term, and an Interim Report will be sent home on Friday, 26th March, which will reflect the period of the recent Lockdown only. Parents Meetings will be held via Teams in the last week of term.

### **Attendance**

Attendance for all pupils is mandatory from 8th March 2021. We ask that all pupils arrive at school promptly. The classrooms will open at 8.50am, with registration taking place at 9.00am. Children should enter school in the same way as we did during the Autumn term.

### **Home Support**

We thank you immensely for the support that you have given your children over the past term. We really appreciate all that you have done. We will continue to set home learning and homework via Class Charts and we ask that all our pupils continue to read with an adult daily.

Reading book packs and homework folders need to come into school only on a Thursday and they will be sent home again on the following Monday, weekly.
