Dear Parents & Carers



Term has started extremely well, and we are very pleased to welcome Year 7, who have made a superb start. We warmly welcome all new parents. At the opposite end of the school, Year 11 have made a wonderful start to the year, the best I can remember. We had an important safeguarding information evening on Thursday last week. It was presented by Mr Jon Galling, Senior Safeguarding Officer, Devon County Council. We intend to run another one later this year and will send letters and texts about it, to ensure as many as possible can attend. It focussed on the risks around social media and the internet and the key message was 'talk to your child' about what they are accessing, and what they see. As you will know, in school, we have strong filters and phones are not allowed to be used, we also teach about the dangers surrounding this. If you couldn't attend the evening, the

presentation slides are available in this issue of Optime, on page 3. Earlier this year, I described this part of life as 'The Wild West', because it has created all sorts of problems for young people: during the evening, amongst other things, access to extremism and pornography were discussed. Please do talk to your child about this.

Chulmleigh College is full. We have 763 pupils on roll and the this year's results were, again, wonderful. A big contributory factor to this is the breadth of opportunity that is available to young people here. As term starts, please do encourage your child to join clubs and activities that are put in place. Thank you for your support.

This year's theme is 'Rebuilding', and there are a number of topics and photographs which can be related to it, giving a broad range of photograph opportunities.


The winner in each category of the local round will receive a voucher worth £30, and will then go forward to the regional round. The deadline for entries is Friday 12th January 2024.


