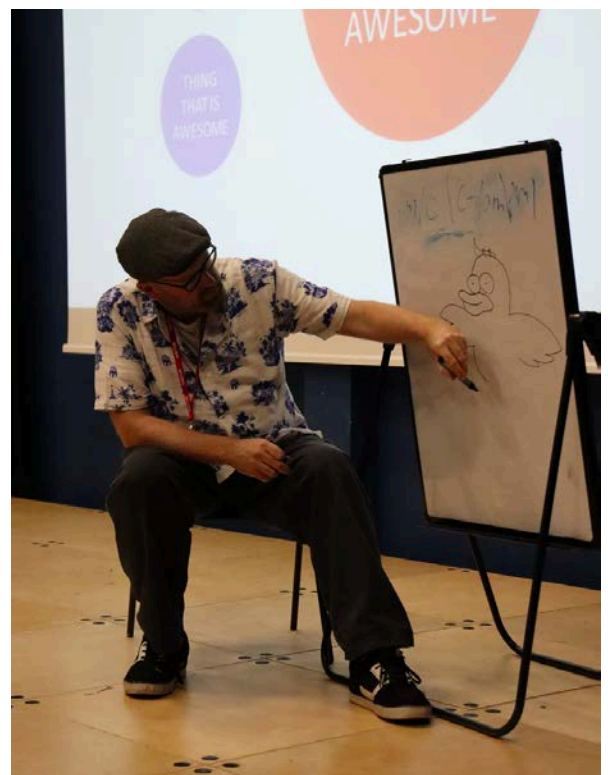

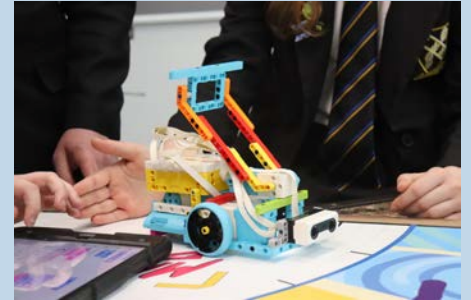
Are you curious about how coding works? Do you love building things, solving problems, or working with robots? Then come and join our brand new Python & Robotics Club, open to all pupils!

We are incredibly proud to celebrate the achievements of former Chulmleigh College pupil, Ewan Botting.

Ewan is now studying Law full-time at the London School of Economics (LSE) – currently ranked #1 university in the UK by The Times 2025 rankings. His path to this point has been anything but easy, yet he has shown immense determination, maturity, and strength throughout.

While at Chulmleigh, Ewan was a standout pupil – serving as Deputy Head Boy, mentoring younger pupils, and going above and beyond to support both his peers whilst focusing on his own studies. Behind the scenes, Ewan also carried the responsibilities of being a young carer for family members – a role he never let stand in the way of his goals.

Despite the challenges he faced, Ewan achieved excellent GCSE results and progressed to Exeter College, where he studied Law, English Literature, and Politics. He achieved impressive A-Level grades of A,A,B, and continued to shine as President of the Law Society, while also running a marathon to raise funds for a charity close to his heart.

Ewan was accepted onto the prestigious Clifford Chance Access Scheme, run by one of the UK's top five law firms – a testament to his talent and potential in the legal field.

His story is one of quiet resilience and unwavering dedication. In the face of real adversity, Ewan remained focused, compassionate, and driven. He is proof that background does not determine success – hard work, courage, and integrity do.

The whole Chulmleigh community wishes him every success as he continues his journey at LSE and beyond.
