Key Stage 3 Enrichment Days - Tuesday 14th July – Thursday 16th July 2026

We are delighted to announce we are launching a series of Enrichment Days for pupils in Year's 7, 8 and 9 during the last full week of the summer term. Year 10 pupils will be undertaking their Work Experience placements during this week, giving them a valuable insight into the world of work.

We are committed to providing pupils with opportunities to learn beyond the classroom, enriching the curriculum offered at Chulmleigh College. Pupils will follow an alternative timetable designed to help them develop new skills, reinforce core values, and promote teamwork.

Over the three Enrichment Days, pupils will take part in a range of activities including day trips, on-site experiences, and the option of a residential visit for each year group. Please note that some activities and trips will involve a cost.

Please take some time with your child/ren to review the attached booklet of activities we have on offer, including the provisional costs for each option. This will help your child choose the activities that interest them most, ensuring they have enjoyable and rewarding days.

While we will do our best to accommodate your child/ren's first choice for each session, we cannot guarantee places if an activity becomes oversubscribed. Therefore, please make sure your child clearly indicates their order of preference for each day. A first choice on one day may also be used as a backup option on another, but no pupil will be allocated the same session twice.

Please note that some activities may be subject to change if there is insufficient interest or due to unforeseen circumstances.

Criteria for Selection

Pupils who are not attending a residential must choose their preferred option each day and 2 back up options.

Year 8 pupils attending the residential may choose from any of the activities and trips available on their other day.

All Year 7 pupils will take part in the Dartmoor trip. The year group will be split so that pupils attending the Year 7 residential still experience the Dartmoor visit on the Thursday.

Day 2: A visit to the Globe Theatre including a workshop and a tour, followed by a visit to the Tower of London, and culminating in the West End Show ‘The Lion King’.

Day 3: A visit to London Zoo before heading back to Chulmleigh.

Breakfast and evening meal will be at the hotel and they will provide packed lunches on day 2 and 3.





Day Trip: Dartmoor

Activity Outline: In groups partake in a walk across Northern Dartmoor experiencing a range of terrain with some stunning views of Dartmoor if it is a clear day! This is a whole cohort trip but is split into 2 days due to numbers. Pupils will be learning about land use and land use conflict/resolution on Dartmoor. This will support classroom learning in Year 8 and cover important issues about sustainability, economic activities, rivers, water supply and habitats.

Cost: £30

Activity Outline: Visit Westward Ho! beach and have a dedicated surfing lesson with the expert local instructors from North Devon Surf School. Westward Ho! beach is the perfect place to either learn how to surf or develop your skills if you already know the basics. All equipment is provided and the total session time is 2 hours. Bring a towel, lunch and some stoke!

The rest of our time at Westward Ho! will be spent exploring Northam Burrows Country Park, which lies within an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty and Site of Special Scientific Interest and the work that goes on to maintain this beautiful place.

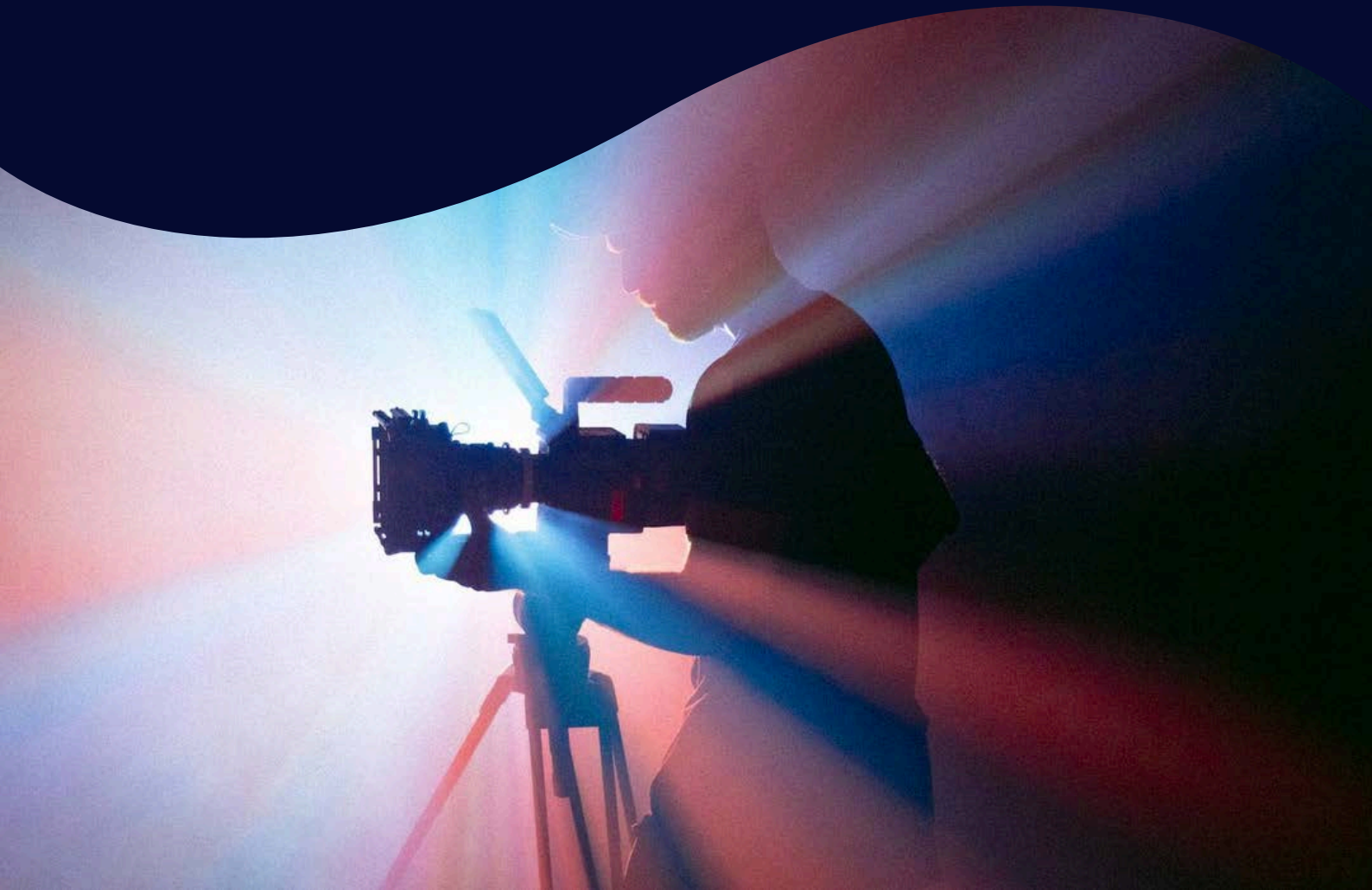

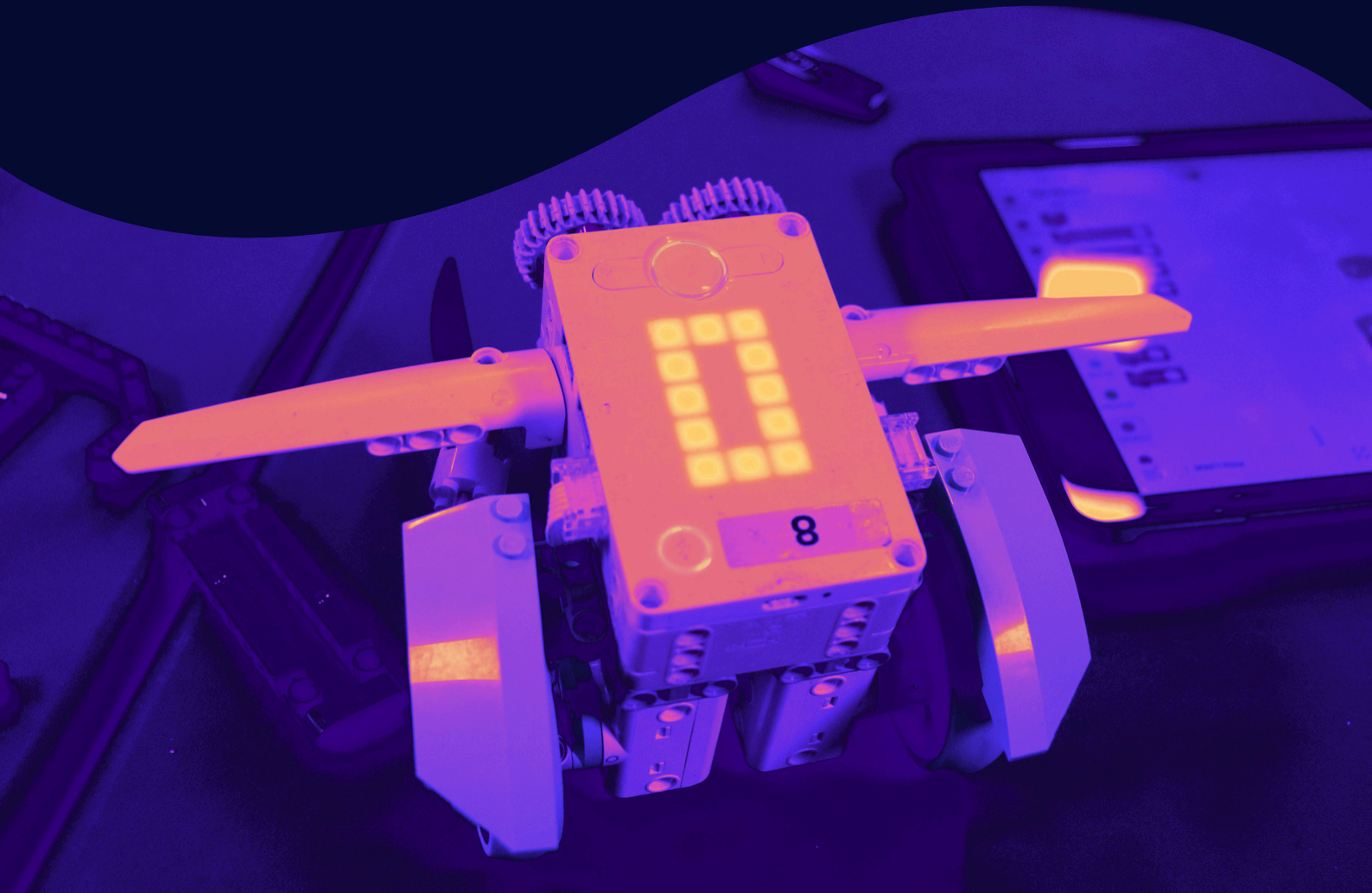

I am writing with details about an exciting opportunity for Year 7 pupils during enrichment week in July 2026.

We are offering a trip to Ultimate Adventure in Appledore near Bideford, North Devon. For pupils who want a taste of adventure in a beautiful setting, this could be the trip for you! Here's the details:

Dates: Tuesday 14th - Wednesday 15th July 2026

Cost: £145 per pupil. This includes transport, accommodation, food and all activities.

The programme is yet to be confirmed, but will include a surf lesson on the Wednesday, plus a range of activities which could include high ropes courses, archery, assault courses, mountain boarding, climbing, kayaking, and stand-up paddleboarding.

It will be a full programme of activities, with all pupils expected to take part in everything with high levels of enthusiasm and good humour. There may be times during activities when pupils are nervous and unsure if they can do it, but this is all part of the package! Hopefully pupils will be able to overcome these fears and anxieties and realise that they are far more capable and courageous than they thought!

As places for this activity will be limited, please pay a deposit of £45 via MyEd +Pay by 28th November to register your interest, along with completing the Microsoft form link in the overview letter.

Should we find the trip is oversubscribed then consideration will be made regarding a pupil's behaviour, attitude to learning and attendance record. After this then names of pupils will be selected in a fair way. A payment schedule will follow once places have been allocated.
