Key words

Fossil fuel- coal, oil and natural gas.

Renewable energy- a way of producing electricity by using a resource that won't run out- eg- the wind or sun

Global warming- the way temperatures around the world are rising.

Greenhouse gases- gases like carbon dioxide and methane that trap heat in the atmosphere.

Fracking- high pressure liquid pumped deep into the ground to release gas.

Key words

Primary- involves taking something from nature eg farming.

Secondary- making a product eg manufacturing.

Tertiary- provides a service.

Quaternary- research and development of new products, services etc

Arable farming- the growing of crops.

Intensive farming- farms which cover a small areas but which use many people and/or a lot of machinery eg a fruit farm.

Extensive farming- Farms which cover a large area but employ a few people eg a sheep farm.

Organic- food grown without the use of chemicals.

Food miles- the distance travelled by food
